

## PERMIAN BASIN YOUTH FOOTBALL LEAGUE

### Procedures that will be in place for practices at City Parks:

- Parents will stay in their vehicles during practices (parents should not leave practice, in case of an emergency).
- Coaches will provide hand sanitizer for before, during, and after practice.
- Each player will bring their own water bottle to practice. No sharing under any circumstances.
- During Drills players will maintain a 6 ft distance while waiting their turn.

### Game Day Procedures (City of Midland)

- Temperature checks for Players, Coaches and refs prior to games.
- One entry and one exit for flow of spectators.
- Gate attendants will not handle money. Spectators will display the money to the attendant and place into a bucket themselves. Money will be sanitized prior to counting at the end of the day.
- Hand Sanitizer at both entry and exit.
- Refs will wipe game ball down after each change of possession.
- Each Player is to bring their own water bottle.
- Spectators will be spaced 6 ft apart.
- Spectators can't go up and down the side line; they will stay in their designated area.
- Only immediate family may attend games to reduce crowding.
- Post-Game teams will line up 5 yards apart and say "Good Game" instead of hand shakes.
- After game no snacks or gift bags to be given away.
- Spectators and teams will exit the field immediately to allow following game to begin without undo crowding.

If Players or Coaches do not abide by these rules, they will not be allowed to attend games or practices. If Parents or Spectators do not abide by these rules, they will not be allowed to attend games or practices. We want to make sure we are all following the rules so our children can play these sports on the City's facilities. By signing below you understand and agree to follow the rules set forth.
